Mr. Lindsay was President Clinton's Assistant to the President for the Office of Management and Administration. Mr. Lindsay oversaw the White House Military Office, which included Air Force One; the White House Communications Agency; the Medical Unit; Camp David; and White House Operations. He also led the Executive Office of the President's Office of Administration, which included the areas of finance, information systems, human resources, legal, appropriations, and security. Mr. Lindsay's office was responsible for over 2500 military and civilian staff throughout the Washington, D.C. area. President Clinton selected Mr. Lindsay to be the operational lead for the White House's 2001 Clinton to Bush Administration transition preparation and execution.

Prior to his White House appointment, Mr. Lindsay served on Capitol Hill as senior legislative aide and counsel to Congressman Louis Stokes (D-OH). He worked closely with Democrat leaders and the Congressional Black Caucus on a number of business and economic issues. He focused on health care and national urban environmental revitalization legislation, and was a member of several Congressional task forces addressing such issues as ethics, affirmative action, Congressional redistricting, welfare reform, technology transfer, economic development, international law and international human rights.

Mr. Lindsay was a member of Senator Hillary Clinton's Minnesota Finance Committee for her 2008 Presidential campaign. In 2008 and 2009 Mr. Lindsay served as the agency review team leader for the Obama-Biden transition for the White House Office of Management and Administration.

Mark Lindsay is a member of the board of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum in Cleveland, Ohio, and is a trustee of Macalester College's Board of Trustees Emeritus in St. Paul, MN. He graduated from Macalester College in St. Paul, Minnesota. He obtained a law degree from Case Western Reserve University School of Law, graduated with a masters degree with a concentration in International Affairs from Georgetown University, and graduated from the Advanced Management Program at the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton Business School. He is a member of the District of Columbia Bar.
