For the maximum period of six years, Livingston served on the House Select Committee on Intelligence.

Ron Klink was elected to Congress in 1992 with a 79% with a margin. Prior to his election Klink was a well known television and radio personality in the Pittsburgh area. He capped off a 24 year broadcast career by reporting and anchoring the news on CBS affiliate KDKA-TV from 1978-1992.

RKA was created in 2001 and has since built a broad clientele in the technology, healthcare and telecommunications industries. The firm and its associates have more than 25 years combined experience at the federal level of government, with specialties in regulatory reform, legislative initiatives and federal procurement.
