Prior to his White House appointment, Lindsay served on Capitol Hill as senior legislative aid and counsel to Congressman Louis Stokes (D-OH). He worked closely with democrats and the Congressional Black Caucus on a number of business and economic issues. He worked on national urban environmental revitalization legislation, and was a member of several Congressional task forces addressing such issues as ethics, affirmative action, Congressional re-districting, welfare reform, technology transfer, economic development, international law and international human rights.

Before joining TLG, Lindsay held a number of senior positions with UnitedHealth Group, one of the world's largest healthcare companies. His roles included President of the AARP Pharmacy Services Division, and Vice President of Public Communications and Strategy, in which he coordinated all of the company's worldwide contacts with the media as central spokesperson and communications leader.

Most recently, Lindsay was a member of Senator Hillary Clinton's Minnesota Finance Committee for her 2008 Presidential campaign. He is a member of the board of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum in Cleveland, Ohio, and is a trustee of Macalester College's Board of Trustees Emeritus in St. Paul, MN.
